LEATHER BOOKMARK

Materials

- Scrap leather
- sturdy scissors
- Leather punch
- Leather stamps
- bowl of water
- sponge
- mallet or hammer

Instructions

- 1. Cut a piece of leather to approximately 1 inch by 6 inches
- 2. Make small cuts on one narrow end to make fringe
- 3. On the other narrow end, approximately 1/2 inch from the edge, punch a hole using the punch and mallet.
- 4. Dip the sponge into the water.
- 5. Use the sponge to wet the leather just until it changes color.
- 6. Use the stamps and mallet to stamp a design into the leather.
- 7. Cut a piece of lacing about 1/8 inch by 6 inches from the remaining scrap leather.
- 8. Fold the lacing in half and force the folded end through the hole in the bookmark.
- 9. Bring the loose ends over the top and through the loop poking through the hole. Tighten and adjust as necessary.
