

CD Fish Craft

Materials

- Two old CDs
- Acrylic Paint
- Paintbrushes
- White card stock or construction paper cut fins, lips, and eyes
- Scissors
- Hot glue gun

Instructions

1. Paint the silver (unprinted) sides of the CDs to look like the sides of a fish. Use brush strokes to make scales.
2. Cut the fins, lips, and two eyes (one for each side) from the construction paper. See the diagram below for a general idea of how to cut them.
3. Glue the fins and lips to the printed (unpainted side of the CD) as shown in the diagram.
4. Apply more glue and glue the second CD to the first so the printed sides of the CDs and the paper parts are on the inside and the sides you painted are on the outside.
5. Glue an eye to each side.
